




# PSA BUSINESS PROCESS AND SYSTEMS REVIEWS

## DCIO/BPSR Focus Area

The Department of Defense (DoD) Deputy Chief Information Officer for Business Process and Systems Review (DCIO/BPSR) co-leads reviews of business processes and supporting systems within the organizations of the Principal Staff Assistants (PSAs), Defense agencies, and Field Activities. The office also manages CIO-related opportunities identified during these reviews. In order to execute its mission, the office established four focus areas: Performance Management, PSA Business Process and Systems Reviews, Data Management, and Analytics. This illustration highlights the second focus area: PSA Business Process and Systems Reviews.

As DoD focuses on reducing the cost of management headquarters and maintaining readiness while modernizing capability, it must continue to scrutinize activities for the purpose of identifying ways to improve effectiveness and agility. In this context, the Deputy Secretary of Defense (DepSecDef) directed the DoD CIO and Deputy Chief Management Officer (DCMO) to review PSA business processes and supporting IT systems (Source: 8 August 2014 DepSecDef Memo, "Implementation Guidance for the Business Process and Systems Review"). The purpose, process, approach, and desired outcome of these reviews are outlined below.
