Mr. Moorefield is currently serving as the Director of Spectrum Policy & Programs for the Department of Defense (DoD) Chief Information Officer (CIO). His primary duties are responsibility for the development and oversight of DoD spectrum policy and strategic plans to ensure the efficient and effective use of the electromagnetic spectrum. He leads the development and representation of DoD positions in national and international forums and provides program oversight for spectrum resource management programs. He has served in this position since Oct 2012.

Mr. Moorefield joined Federal service in 1989 in the Air Force as a civil servant, where he served for 19 years doing Research and Develop and Acquisition. He also served in DISA at the Joint Spectrum Center for 4 years where he was first introduced to spectrum management.
