SUBJECT: Implementation Guidance to Establish an Initial DoD Enterprise Directory Service

This memorandum provides DoD CIO implementation guidance to establish an initial DoD Enterprise Directory Service (EDS) capability by using existing Department services. This initial DoD EDS capability will provide both a White Pages service and email Global Address List (GAL) that will be used to discover personnel and their associated contact attributes across the DoD.

DoD Components will expose their Active Directory Forests or other Contact Attribute Directory Service in accordance with the "DoD Enterprises Services Directory Capability - Contact Attribute Specification", version 2.0, dated 14 July 2009, on both SIPRNet and NIPRNet, by opening the necessary ports to allow EDS a continuous read-only access account that will enable continual harvesting of attributes. The attached Enterprise Directory Component Data Access Timeline sets the completion schedule for Components to provide continual read-only data access to EDS. For those Components that have already provided access, either directly or through an intermediate meta-directory GAL, no further action is required.



In the near term, EDS will be provided by the Defense Information Systems Agency (DISA) Joint Enterprise Directory Services (JEDS). This current capability will harvest, aggregate, and then re-publish Component consolidated personnel contact data as a DoD GAL for consumption by Component email clients in accordance with the above referenced specification.

Oversight for executing this tasking will be through the Enterprise Guidance Board governance structure with DISA reporting monthly on progress to the Enterprise Services Review Group.
