

How can I apply for DoD CITEP?

Outbound

Matching and Introductions: Component identifies candidate resume and opportunity, coordinates with DoD CIO to verify capacity, component and industry leaders hold introductory meeting with seniors and candidate.

3-Party Agreement: Component drafts 3-Party Agreement and reviewed by industry, candidate signs 3PA, Component OGC reviews and signs 3PA, Industry authorized approving official reviews and signs 3PA, component authorized approving official reviews and signs 3PA, lastly DoD CIO CIEP POC signs 3PA.

Out-Processing: Candidate initiates industry onboarding, candidates gets TDY approval from component, candidate secures housing for non-local TDY, out-processes with their component.

Inbound

Complete all outbound steps plus

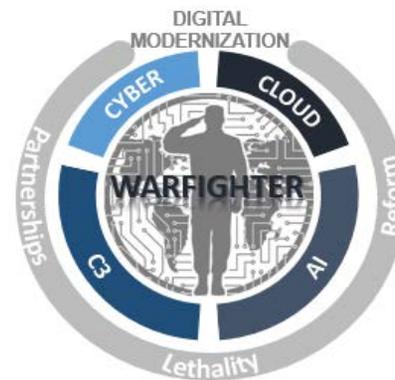
HR & Security: Component sends package to HR for processing and approval, Component initiates security clearance passing, component initiates onboarding.

Onboarding: Security sends CAC forms to candidate, component processes CAC, complete 2875 and request accounts for candidate, component provides ethics training and NDA to candidate.

Returns & Extensions

30-45 calendar days before end of rotation: Component and Industry communicate a return date for candidate, component and industry must agree and process extension, send extension 3PA to DoD CIO for signature, must complete rotation after 1 year assignment.

Background

The Cyber Information Technology Exchange Program (CITEP) established by the FY10 NDAA, previously known as Information Technology Exchange Program (ITEP), provides a unique opportunity for DoD civilian IT employees and private sector organizations to exchange personnel. The program is designed to help bridge the culture and priority gaps between Industry and the Department. Exchange is 3 months intervals with only 1 year option.

CITEP Personnel Requirements

Civilian IT professionals involved in "planning, organizing, staffing, directing, integrating or controlling of information technology, including occupational specialty areas such as system administration, IT project management, network services, operating systems, software application, cybersecurity, enterprise architecture, policy and planning, internet/web services, customer support, data management and system analysis."
