DCWF Feedback Request

The DoD recently commenced work to refresh the DoD Cyber Workforce Framework (DCWF). In support of this work, the DoD CIO released the DCWF Feedback Request tasker (CIO000576-20) to gather input for work roles within Cybersecurity, Information Technology, and Cyberspace Enabler workforce elements. The suspense for returning consolidated feedback is **October 5, 2020**.

The Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence and Security (USD(I&S)) and Principal Cyber Advisor (PCA) are concurrently gathering feedback for work roles within Intelligence (Cyberspace), and Cyberspace Effects. We collectively look forward to working with Components to ensure the DCWF remains valid, addresses DoD baseline equities, and meets evolving mission needs.
